

2023 Hillsborough Pool Party Rules

Thank you for choosing the Hillsborough Pool for your party. Your party date and time is: July 10th from 5:30-8:30 (which includes set up and clean up)

Your Guard(s) are: Kate Moeller and Paul Moeller

Please read the following rules:

1. Hillsborough POA Pool Rules are attached to the confirmation email for your reference.
2. Please leave the pool deck and furniture as you found it.
3. Place all trash in provided receptacles.
4. NO GLASS is allowed.
5. You are welcome to bring food and drinks.
6. No open alcoholic beverages are allowed.
7. You may use the refrigerator and freezer for your party if needed.
8. You may decorate if you clean up afterwards.
9. Party must end at 4:30 or 8:30 p.m. based on start time. a. The guards will be compensated for their time at the rate of \$5 per every ten (10) minutes that the party goes over the allotted time.
10. Guards must be paid in cash \$45 (each)
 - a. If you have over 15 swimmers, you must have two (2) guards.
11. You are responsible for all your guests and their behavior.
12. The lifeguard has the right to ask anyone to leave for violation of HPOA Pool Rules at any time.
13. Children under seven (7) who are non-swimmers must be within "touch" reach of parent/guardian at all times. This includes the pool deck, the concession area, restrooms and the pool or wear a US Coast Guard approved flotation device at all times. No exception.
14. Small children MUST be supervised on slide at all times.
15. You will be held responsible for any damage caused to the pool by yourself or your guests.
